Duplicate content items to make similar ones in the same course

Upload images from your computer and select from preset sizes

Upload and embed images from your computer and easily crop and resize (by the pixel) the images.

Search and embed images from Pexels or Unsplash without having to leave your course

Create folders of images at the institution or subaccount level that can be used across courses.

See and resolve a number of accessibility issues on a page

Use a variety of accessibility checkers that group similar issues together, provide a better understanding of the issues, and assist in fixing them.

Receive guidance to further improve accessibility, including descriptive link text, proper alt text for embedded math equations, and heading hierarchy.

Bulk edit assignment due dates to shift dates forward

Bulk update dates and/or times when assignments and pages will be due, lock and/or unlock, including the option to shift dates forwards or backwards by a specific amount of days.

Bulk update your Announcement deploy dates, including the option to shift dates forwards or backwards by a specific amount of days.

Create rubrics

Enable the option to make rubrics sortable so that anyone editing a rubric can move criteria up or down the rubric table

PLUS...

The Library: Search an ever-growing library full to the brim with community-created shared assets that can be pulled into your Canvas courses

External assets tool: Identify files that are stored outside of the current course and easily import them into the course so they are visible to students.

Action Items tool: Embed action items (hidden from students) to help instructors with course-building and/or guide course designers to meet quality standards

Mobile Compatibility Checker: Preview your content on different screen sizes and rest easy knowing your beautiful pages are mobile-friendly

Style editor: Use advanced styling tools to create an endless number of styles that can be saved and applied to course elements

Quick Style Manager: Share styles created with the Style Editor with colleagues or at the institutional or sub-account level

Table to Columns: Convert tables used for layout purposes into accessible and mobile-responsive columns with the click of a button

Objectives Tool: Insert prewritten, recurring program or course objectives, competencies, or other standards

Policies Tool: Provide consistent, institutionally-sanctioned content that appears in courses and is updated by the institution

Advanced Editor: Target a specific element on the page and view only the portion of HTML relevant to that element, rather than having to browse through the full code to find it

Attributes: Add/adjust IDs, classes, styles, titles, dir, and lang for specific elements without having to enter the code view
